



## KINGS SOCCER ACADEMY SUPER Y-LEAGUE GIRLS U13, U15, U17

The Super Y-League addresses the need for a national youth league to further develop the upper 1% of youth soccer players throughout the United States. Instead of having talented players spread out among several local clubs and playing against each other in local leagues, the Super Y-League promotes bringing together the best possible players within each city to compete against teams of similar talent within their region in a home and away format. The Super Y-League is going to be the most competitive youth league in the United States.

The league is noted for its unique approach to recruiting and its ability to raise the bar for the best players in the country. It has several non-traditional components including worldwide recruiting, a 26-person pool from which game-day players can be chosen, strict venue regulations and vertical integration (players are allowed to play-up). Super Y-League teams are not registered through USYSA state associations, but instead register directly with US Soccer. This allows the players to simultaneously participate in USYSA competitions and in the Super Y-League. They can also come from various clubs and return/play with their regular clubs with no strings attached at any time.

Along with excellent coaching and high-level competition, there is now another reason to consider participation on a Super Y team -- its relationship to the Olympic Development Program (ODP). ODP is run by the U.S. National Team with the intent of identifying players with high potential.

The Kings will participate in the Midwest Division compete against the Cleveland Internationals (OH, West Michigan Fire (MI), Toronto Lynx (Canada), London Gryphon's (Canada), Mequon United (WI), Chicago Fire, Penns Forest (PA) and the Chicago Magic amongst others.
